

## Instructors/Coaches

As we approach our first tournament back as we Return to Golf, we wanted to take this opportunity to review a few things prior to your on-site arrival at any event in the near future.

As a reminder, Instructors/Coaches are considered “outside of the bubble” and will not require testing for COVID-19. However, anyone entering the grounds at a PGA TOUR or Korn Ferry Tour event must go through a screening process that includes thermal scanning and a short questionnaire.

With a very limited number of people allowed on-site, it is important that you notify the PGA TOUR of your attendance. With that said, it is **MANDATORY** for you to register using the Player Support website: <https://playersupport.pgatourhq.com/> for PGA TOUR events. Click ‘Pre-Registration’ at the top of the page and scroll to register. Please be aware players are also required to inform us of their support teams’ attendance at events. In addition to registering for the tournament on the player support site, you will also find the tournament matrix which will provide details on parking, access, security gates, and dining.

During these first four weeks your access to the course and tournament facilities will be different than what you are used to. Your normal access to the locker room and clubhouse will be restricted and social distancing will be required at all times.

Your range and practice area access will also be modified, and the use of a practice area access credential will be in effect. At registration, a player will be provided with a range access credential to be used by a member of his support team (instructor/coach/trainer/manufacture etc.). The player will note his support personnel’s name on the credential envelope and leave the practice area credential at the on-site distribution center. The support team member must go to the distribution center to obtain the practice area credential and wear the practice area badge in conjunction with a season long or tournament credential noting a ‘P’ designation. If the practice area credential needs to be used by another member of a player’s support team, it should be returned to the on-site distribution center for proper sanitation and then redistributed.

Support personnel should plan to observe the player at a minimum of six feet away and are not allowed to touch the player, his clubs, or his bag. A rope line will be added to the range - approximately 8-10 ft behind the hitting bays - as an added safety measure. Please stand behind this rope line at all times when working with your player. We also strongly recommend that a face covering or mask be worn when working with a player.

The safety and well-being of everyone on-site continues to be our #1 priority. We appreciate your continued support of these measures and look forward to the return of the PGA TOUR. If you have any questions, please let us know.
